Entrance examination guidelines for Bachelor of Arts Bachelor of Legislative Law (BALLB) Program

Introduction

Admission into BALLB program will be on merit. Gandaki University will conduct a BALLB Admission Test, a National Level Entrance Examination for admission to Bachelor of Arts Bachelor of Laws (BALLB) program offered by the university.

Applicant must secure at least 40 marks to be considered in selection pool.

Test Structure

There are 100 test items. Each question is provided with four answer options in which only one option is correct and rest of the options are distractors. The questions will be based on the SEE and SLC (Grade XII) or equivalent level courses.

The test covers four sections. The details of the test are as follows:

Law

General concept of Jurisprudence and law, purpose of law, classification, types of law and sources of law, Law and Society: Importance and role of law in society, Concept of Human rights and its principle, Major International human right instruments, Constitution and organs of state, Basic idea and scope of legal profession, Fundamental rights and duties under the Constitution of Nepal 2072

B.S, Concept of Property, Rights and duties, Person and personality, Concept of justice, Morality and Law, Nepali legal system and its evolution.

General English

Vocabulary, Spelling Mistakes, Synonyms and Antonyms, Rearrangement of word in sentences, English comprehension, Para Jumbles, Fill in the blanks, Articles, English Usage errors, Idioms and Phrases, Cloze Test, One-word substitution, Spotting errors, Analogies, Inappropriate usage of words.

Social Studies

Concept of society; Types of society; Fundamental elements of society; Notion of Culture; Concept of development; Infrastructures for development; Indigenous knowledge, skills and technologies; Nepalese traditions, Social Values and Norms; Social problems and solutions; Civic consciousness; Election; Geography of Nepal; Major historical events in Nepal and the world; International Relations, peace and co-operation.

Analytical and Logical Reasoning

Number Test, Relationship Test, Analogy Test, Alpha Numeric Symbol Sequence, Insert Missing Sequence Test, Direction and Distance Test, Classification (Odd Man Out) Test, Time Sequence Test, Logical Word Sequence Test, Statement Arguments, Mathematical Operations, Series Test, Logic Test, Data Arrangement Test, Statements Assumptions, Ranking Test.

General Knowledge

Science, Sports, Current Affairs (geographical, social, cultural, religious, environment, political, state affairs, legal, judicial, national and international contemporary issues and Gandaki University affairs), Awards, Technology and Internet, General Polity, Economic studies.

Merit list and admission criteria

Admissions will be strictly on the basis of merit list. The merit list will be formulated based on entrance exam score (80%) and CGPA obtained in SEE (10%) and SLC (Grade XII) (10%).
